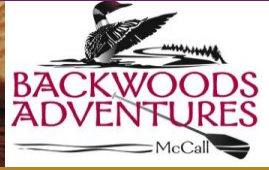

## DESCRIPTION

On the longest and most challenging of our kayaking expeditions, this program finds you paddling along the 65 mile stretch of untamed coast between Loreto and La Paz. Kayaking five to fourteen miles a day, we'll change camps daily (with one overlap).

You'll explore remote coves and inlets, and experience excellent snorkeling; hike hidden canyons full of fascinating geology, and even visit a few small villages and the ruins of a Jesuit mission to sample a bit of local history and culture.

Our motorized support boat carries all camping equipment, personal gear, and the makings for delicious meals. There are even fresh water showers. The crew handles most camp chores and prepares all meals.

This is one of Stef's favorite paddles, she will share with you the enthusiasm she has for Baja - built by decades spent on these waters.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

October 18<sup>th</sup> -27<sup>th</sup> 2011

\$1642/person based on double occupancy

- This 10-day trip begins with arrival in Loreto on the 18<sup>th</sup> and ends with a night in a seaside hotel in La Paz on the 26<sup>th</sup>. (departures on the 27<sup>th</sup>)
- 2 nights hotel/ 7 nights comfortable, catered camping
- Sleep kit, snorkel gear and single or double kayaks are provided
- Level of difficulty: Can be challenging; paddling 5-14 miles each day\*
- Maximum no. of participants: 16

*\* Much of the challenge is determined by the weather and the strength and experience level of the group. Energetic people, and those who like being active, should be able to enjoy and participate fully in this trip.*
